LICENSES

**Chapter 16
LICENSES**

Sec. 16-1. Required.

No person shall engage in any occupation, business or calling coming under the provisions of this Article unless he shall first obtain a license for the same. (1975 Code)

Sec. 16-2. Application.

Any person desiring to enter into or carry on any business, trade or calling within the City shall first make application to the City Clerk for a license so to do, giving such information as may be desired by the Clerk relative to such person's activities. (1975 Code)

Sec. 16-3. Fees.

Before any license shall be issued under this Article, the applicant therefore, shall pay a fee of \$24.00. (1975 Code)

Sec. 16-4. Proration of Fee.

Should any license be issued under the provisions of this Article for a period of time less than one (1) year, the licensee shall pay a sum in proportion to the fractional part of the year that such license shall be valid, but in any event, not less than \$12.00. (1975 Code)

Sec. 16-5. Disposition of Receipts.

All moneys derived from the collection of licenses and license taxes under the provision of this Article shall be paid into the general revenue fund of the City. (1975 Code)

Sec.16-6. Issuance.

Any license applied for under the provisions of this Article shall be issued only upon compliance by the applicant therefore with all applicable provisions of this Code of Ordinances, State law or City ordinances, rules and regulations. (1975 Code)

Sec. 16-7. Duration.

Every license issued under this Article shall be valid for one year, and shall expire on the last day of June following the issuance thereof. (1975 Code)

Sec. 16-8. Display.

Every license issued under this Article shall be displayed by the licensee in a conspicuous place in his place of business readily visible to the customers. In the event the licensee has no fixed place of business, he shall carry his license at all times he is engaged in his business within the City. (1975 Code)

Sec. 16-9. Suspension, Revocation.

(a) The Board of Aldermen of the City of Iberia, Missouri, may upon hearing, suspend or revoke any license issued under the provisions of this Article, for good cause shown, first having given such licensee not less than ten days notice in writing of the application to suspend or revoke his license prior to order of suspension or revocation issuing, which said notice shall contain the grounds for such suspension or revocation set out therein, which notice shall command the licensee to be present at the regular or called meeting of the City Council and show cause, if any, why such license should not be revoked or suspended. Provided, that such licensee shall have full right to be represented by counsel at said hearing, and may produce witnesses and evidence in his behalf at such hearing. Provided further, that such notice of suspension or revocation hearing shall be served by the Police Chief and may be served upon the licensee or a copy thereof left with the licensee or any person in charge of the place of business of said licensee.

(b) The grounds for suspension or revocation of the license issued under the provision of this Article shall be the violation by the licensee of any applicable provision of this Code, State law or City ordinance, rules or regulation. (1975 Code)

Sec. 16-10. Length of Suspension or Revocation.

The suspension provided for herein shall be for a period of one (1) day to thirty (30) days and the revocation provided for herein shall be for a period of one (1) year from the date of such revocation, and the Board shall not issue another license hereunder to a person whose license has been revoked under this Section for the duration of the suspension or revocation, and in the event any such license is suspended or revoked, no portion of the license fee shall be refunded to the licensee. (1975 Code)
