**ARTICLE II  
POLICE JUDGE**

**Sec. 8-11. Office of Police Judge Created.**

There is hereby created and established, the office of Police Judge, in and for the City of Iberia, Missouri. (1975 Code)

**Sec. 8-12. Term.**

The Police Judge shall be appointed by the Mayor of the City of Iberia, with the advice and consent of the Board of Aldermen, and shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen. (1975 Code)

**Sec. 8-13. Jurisdiction.**

The Police Judge shall have exclusive jurisdiction to hear and determine all offenses against the provisions of this Code of Ordinances, and the Ordinances of the City. (1975 Code)

**Sec. 8-14. Compensation.**

The Police Judge shall receive as his salary, the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00) a month. (1975 Code)

**Sec. 8-15. Monthly Report.**

The Police Judge shall be herewith charged with the additional duty of filing a written report of all convictions, fines and costs received in his Court which report shall be furnished to the Mayor and the Board of Aldermen each month. (1975 Code)

**Sec. 8-16. Disposition of Costs.**

All costs levied in all cases, coming before the Police Court, upon which a conviction is had, shall be remitted to the City Clerk for deposit in the General Fund of the City. (1975 Code)

**Sec. 8-17. Costs.**

The Court costs for the City or Police Court for Iberia, Missouri, are hereby set at \$12.00 per case, together with any additional fees for the service of wills, subpoenas, and mileage of officers involved therein.

(a) The designated officials of the Iberia Municipal Court responsible for collecting court costs and fines may assess as Court costs up to two dollars (\$2.00) for

each court proceeding filed for violations of the ordinances of the City of Iberia, Missouri, provided that no such fee shall be collected for non-moving traffic violations, and no such fee shall be collected in any proceeding in such court when the proceeding or defendant has been dismissed by the Court.

(b) Such fees collected shall be transmitted monthly to the Treasurer of the City of Iberia, Missouri, to be used for training law enforcement officers. (1975 Code)

### **Sec. 8-18. Training of Peace Officers.**

(a) The official responsible for collecting court costs and fines may assess as court costs up to three dollars for each violation of the general criminal laws of the State, including infractions, or violations of the ordinances of the City of Iberia, provided that no such fee shall be collected for non-moving traffic violations, and no such fee shall be collected for violations of fish and game regulations, and no such fee shall be collected in any proceeding in any court when the proceeding or defendant has been dismissed by the court.

(b) Two dollars of such fees collected shall be transmitted monthly to the Treasurer of the City of Iberia, to be used locally for training law enforcement officers. One dollar of such fees collected shall be deposited into the Peace Officer Standards and Training Commission Fund, to be used statewide for training law enforcement officers.
